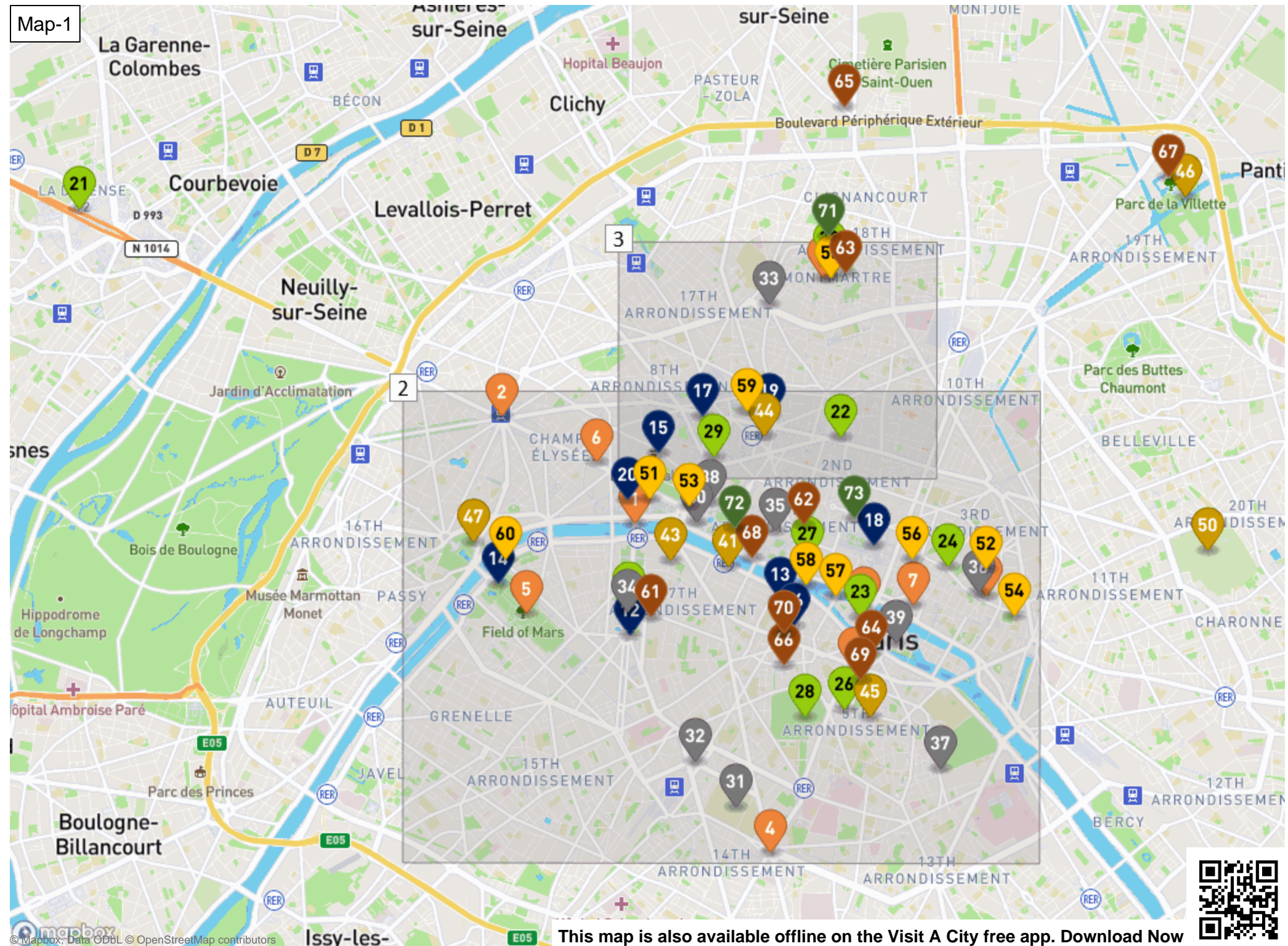
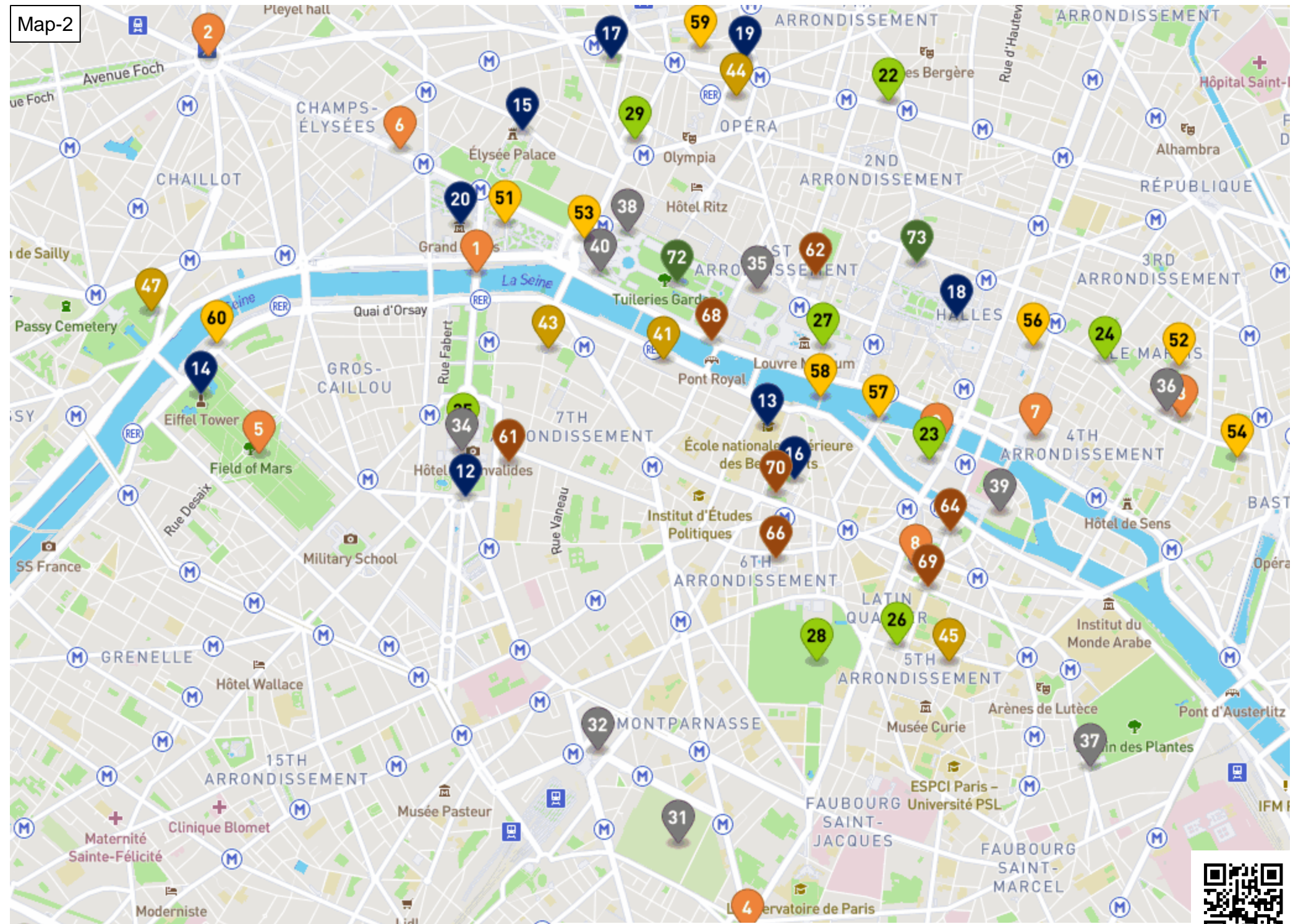

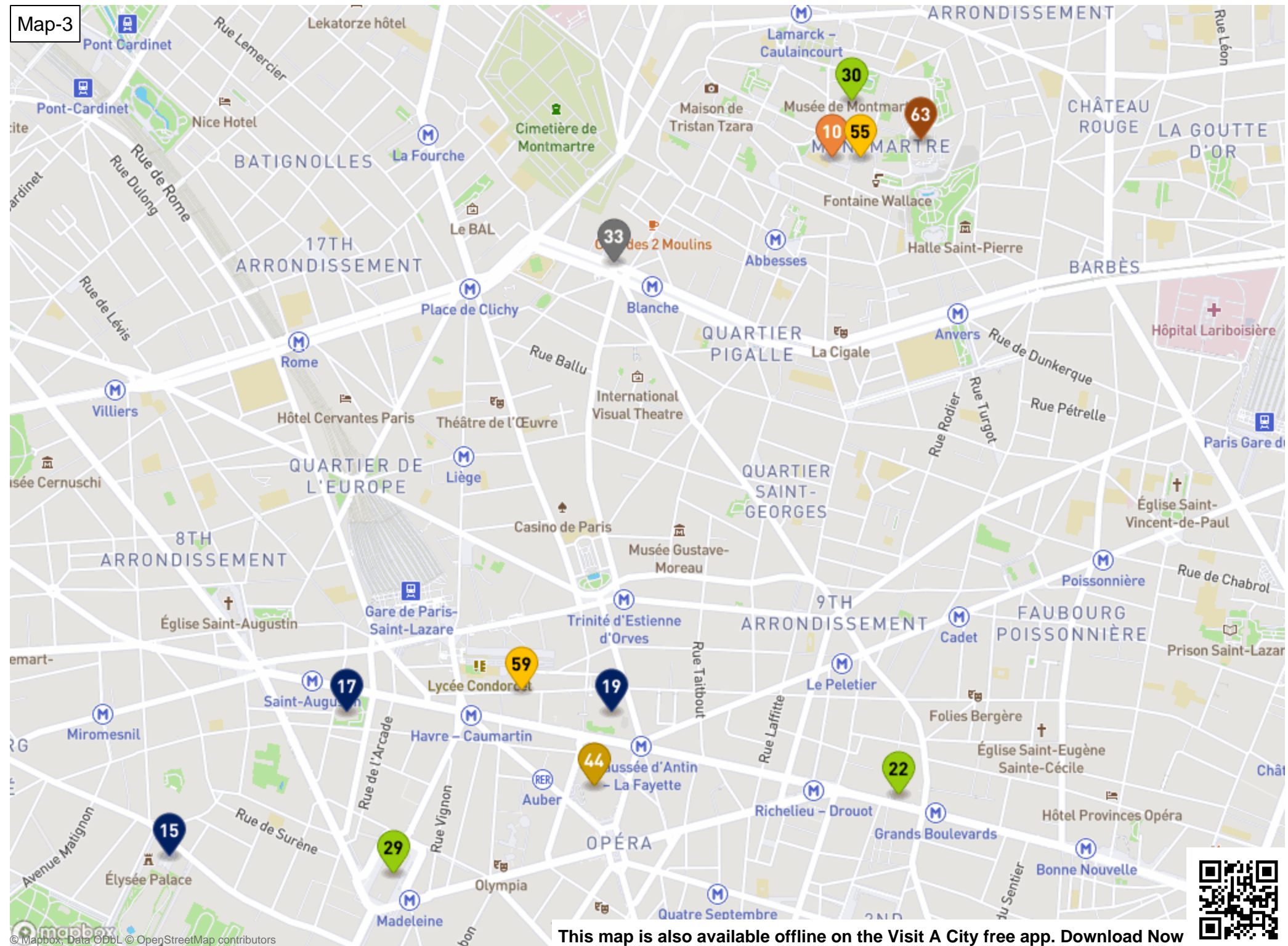

- 1 **Alexander Bridge**
This deck arch bridge spanning the Seine is the most beautiful in Paris (Map-1,2)
- 2 **Arc de Triomphe**
An iconic Paris site which is the world's biggest and tallest triumphal arch (Map-1,2)
- 3 **Carnavalet Museum**
The history of Paris is the focus of this museum in two historic mansions (Map-1,2)
- 4 **Catacombs**
Ancient man-made underground burial chambers (Map-1,2)
- 5 **Champ de Mars**
A stretch of park running from the Eiffel Tower to Ecole Militaire (Map-1,2)
- 6 **Champs Elysees**
This 1.9km long avenue is lined with the most prestigious and expensive stores (Map-1,2)
- 7 **City Hall**
Hotel de Ville has been the hub of political life in Paris since 1500 (Map-1,2)
- 8 **Cluny Museum**
A museum of the Middle Ages and includes in situ Roman baths (Map-1,2)
- 9 **Conciergerie**
Historical monument famous for its role in the French Revolution
- 10 **Dali Museum**
Espace Dali has Frances largest collection original works by Salvador Dali (Map-1,3)
- 11 **Disneyland Paris**
Paradise for kids offering all that the USA theme parks offer
- 12 **Dome Church**
Dome des Invalides is an opulent church holding Napoleon I's tomb (Map-1,2)
- 13 **Ecole National des Beaux Arts**
A leading fine arts school housed in an historic building (Map-1,2)
- 14 **Eiffel Tower**
This free-standing iron tower is the ultimate symbol of Paris (Map-1,2)
- 15 **Elysee Palace**
A majestic palace now the home of the President of France (Map-1,2,3)
- 16 **Eugène Delacroix Museum**
The work of artist Eugene Delacroix is displayed in his former home (Map-1,2)
- 17 **Expiatoire Chapel**
A neo-classical structure built 1826 dedicated to Louis XVI and Marie Antoinette (Map-1,2,3)
- 18 **Forum des Halles**
A shopping Mecca built on the site of the historic fresh food market (Map-1,2)
- 19 **Galleries Lafayette**
Flagship shopping center for up market goods in gorgeous building (Map-1,2,3)
- 20 **Grand Palais**
An historic ornate Beaux-art building with exhibition halls and a museum (Map-1,2)
- 21 **Grande Arche de la Défense**
Le Grande Arche is a modern Triumphal Arch monument (Map-1)
- 22 **Grevin Wax Museum**
Wax figures depict scenes from French history in a baroque building (Map-1,2,3)
- 23 **Holy Chapel**
The 13th century Gothic Sainte-Chapelle has stunning stained glass (Map-1,2)
- 24 **Hotel de Soubise**
An exquisite palacial home housing the Museum of French History (Map-1,2)
- 25 **Hotel des Invalides**
A complex of buildings and exhibits related to the military history of France (Map-1,2)
- 26 **Latin Quarter**
Quaint historic student quarter with narrow lanes and cafes (Map-1,2)
- 27 **Louvre Museum**
One of the finest and largest art museums in the world (Map-1,2)
- 28 **Luxembourg Gardens**
17th century gardens of Luxembourg Palace, home of the Medici Fountain (Map-1,2)
- 29 **Madeleine Church**
This church's neo-classical architecture resembled a Greek temple (Map-1,2,3)
- 30 **Montmartre District**
The picturesque hill top neighborhood where artists and philosophers would meet (Map-1,3)

Moulin Rouge

The ultimate French cabaret venue where the can-can was born (Map-1,3)

Musee de l'armee

A military museum in Les Invalides (Map-1,2)

Museum of Decorative Arts

Decorative arts and design are on display in the Pavilion de Marsan (Map-1,2)

Museum of Jewish Art and History

Learn about the history of Parisian Jews through their art (Map-1,2)

Museum of Natural History

An extensive collection including the Gallery of Evolution and the Menagerie (Map-1,2)

38

Musée du Jeu de Paume

Museum of modern and postmodern media and photography (Map-1,2)

39

Notre Dame

A historic cathedral on Ile de la Cite known for its Gothic architecture (Map-1,2)

40

Orangerie Museum

Impressionist and post-impressionist art museum (Map-1,2)

41

Orsay Museum

Housed in a 1900 Beaux-art station building it holds famous art works (Map-1,2)

42

Palace of Versailles

Equisite palace where Louis XIV lived and treaties were signed in the Hall of Mirrors

43

Palais Bourbon

A grand neo-classical building now home of the French National Assembly (Map-1,2)

44

Palais Garnier Opera House

This grand theatre founded by Louis XIV has opulent palace-like décor (Map-1,2,3)

45

Pantheon

A neo-classical 1700s church now a mausoleum for distinguished figures (Map-1,2)

46

Parc de la Villette

A huge park and site of several cultural venues (Map-1)

47

Paris Aquarium

A display of water creatures, walk-through tunnel, hand-on displays and more (Map-1,2)

48

Paris Zoo

The zoo has 5 habitat areas for animals from across the globe

49

Park Asterix

An Asterix-themed amusement park

50

Pere Lachaise Cemetery

The biggest cemetery in the City of Paris that is the final resting place for many celebrities

51

Petit Palais

Home to the City of Paris Museum of Fine Arts (Map-1,2)

Picasso Museum

The work of Picasso is displayed in a 17th century mansion (Map-1,2)

53

Place de la Concorde

Paris' largest square at the end of the Champs-Élysées (Map-1,2)

54

Place des Vosges

The oldest and one of the most beautiful squares in Paris (Map-1,2)

55

Place du Tertre

This public square is known for its many street artists (Map-1,3)

56

Pompidou Center

A modern cultural center and art gallery with unique architecture (Map-1,2)

57

Pont Neuf Bridge

Paris' oldest bridge spanning the Seine and crossing Ile de la Cite (Map-1,2)

58

Pont des Arts

Pedestrian bridge across the Seine that serves as a popular picnic spot and art exhibition venue

Printemps

A department store selling a wide range of products (Map-1,2,3)

River Cruise

Take a cruise through historic Paris and see sites from the water (Map-1,2)

Dedicated to the works of sculpture Auguste Rodin (Map-1,2)
- 62** **Royal Palace**
Grand royal home and Cardinal Richelieu's residence in the 1600s (Map-1,2)
- 63** **Sacre Coeur Basilica**
An iconic landmark this white domed cathedral is on Butte Montmartre (Map-1,3)
- 64** **Saint Julien le Pauvre**
A Gothic-style 13th century Greek Orthodox Church (Map-1,2)
- 65** **Saint Ouen Flea Market**
Marche aux Puces St-Ouen is a legendary flea market for bargain hunters (Map-1,3)
- 66** **Saint Sulpice**
This exquisite church has a famous organ and sundial gnomon (Map-1,2)
- 67** **Science Museum**
Kids discover scientific principles through hands-on, multimedia displays (Map-1)
- 68** **Seine River Walk**
Walk along the banks of the river passed famous sites (Map-1,2)
- 69** **Sorbonne University**
France's most famous university and alma mater of many historic figures (Map-1,2)
- 70** **St Germain des Prés**
A quaint area with historic cafes and interesting stores (Map-1,2)

- 71** **The Jewish Art Muesum**
Jewish art treasured displayed in an historic mansion (Map-1)
- 72** **Tuileries Gardens**
Former garden of the Tuileries Palace created in 1564 and now a park (Map-1,2)
- 73** **Wine Tasting at O Chateau**
Discover French wines at this well known bar (Map-1,2)
