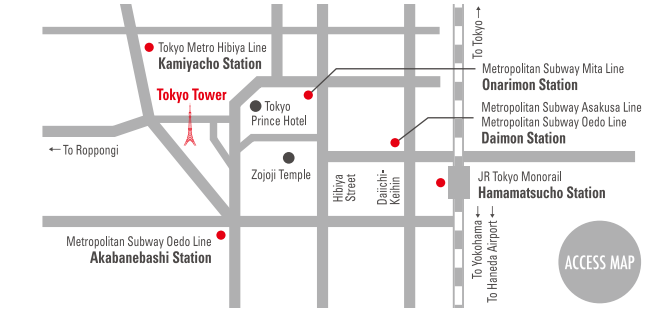

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

**Special Observatory at Night**  
A science fiction-like atmosphere was added to the interior of the Special Observatory, making visitors feel like they are in the future floating in space. The lavatories in particular are a must-see. At night the LEDs (light emitting diodes) inlaid under the windows emit glimmering light in blue, red, and green and together with the audio effect create a dramatic atmosphere full of fantasy as you enjoy looking down at the nightscape.

**Odaiba**  
"Odaiba" is a popular sightseeing and date area in Tokyo. There are many entertainment facilities, including "Venus Fort" containing outlet stores and gigantic shopping spot "Diver City," and famous tourist attractions.



**Rainbow Bridge**  
It is a beautiful suspension bridge in Tokyo bay which is the symbol of Tokyo waterfront city. Walkway on the bridge, free of charge, is a recommended spot. You can enjoy the fabulous view of you-have-never-seen Tokyo from cruisers on the blue ocean at night scene of Tokyo waterfront city.



**Roppongi Hills**  
Roppongi Hills securing its position as a landmark of Tokyo. There are various culture/educational facilities such as Mori art museum, Tokyo city view (observatory), Roppongi hills club, Roppongi academyhills on the top floor. It is the symbol of "cultural city".



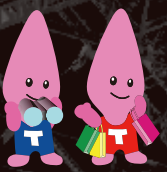
**Tokyo Midtown**  
This is a tourist attraction that opened in March 2007. It is a multi-commercial facility containing specialty shops and restaurants, a five star hotel, art and design facilities, and rental housing.



**Zojoji**  
This is the main temple of the Jodo-shu of Buddhism and also is the family temple of Tokugawa family. Hiroshige Utagawa drew this temple in his Edo-Hyakkai (one hundreds scenes of Edo). Recently this temple is attracting people as a power spot within Tokyo metropolitan area.



**The National Art Center, Tokyo**  
This is the fifth national art institution. It has one of the largest exhibition space in Japan serving as a venue of various exhibitions. You can enjoy not only art exhibition but also shop and restaurant.

Generous supplies which focus on new Tokyo souvenir! First official eating tour in Tokyo Tower!!

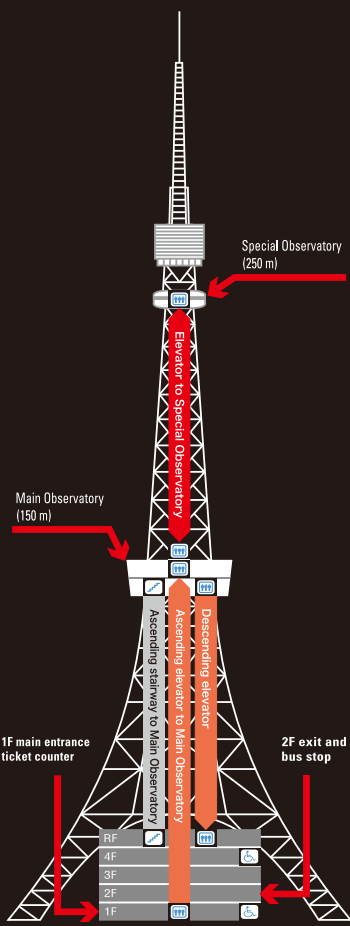


**Aquarium gallery**
