Location: In the middle and eastern parts of China and is on the middle and lower reaches of the Yellow River, on the southeast of the Yellow-Huaihe-Haihe River Plain and adjacent to Hebei, Shanxi, Shaanxi, Hubei, Anhui and Shandong Provinces.

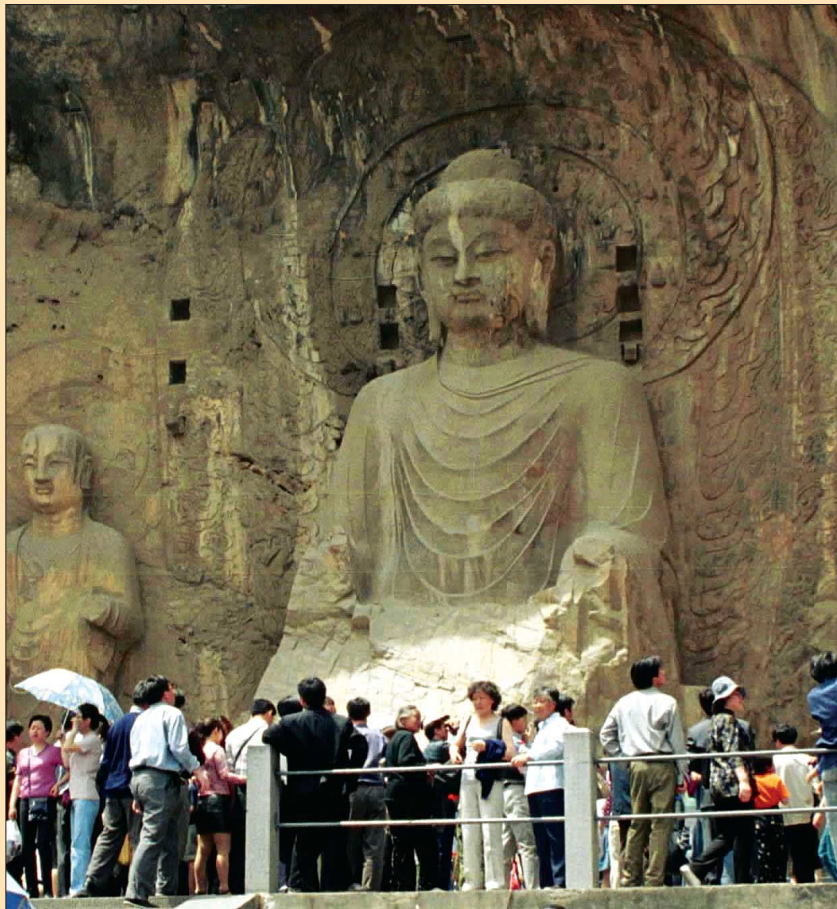
- Average annual temperature: 13-15°C

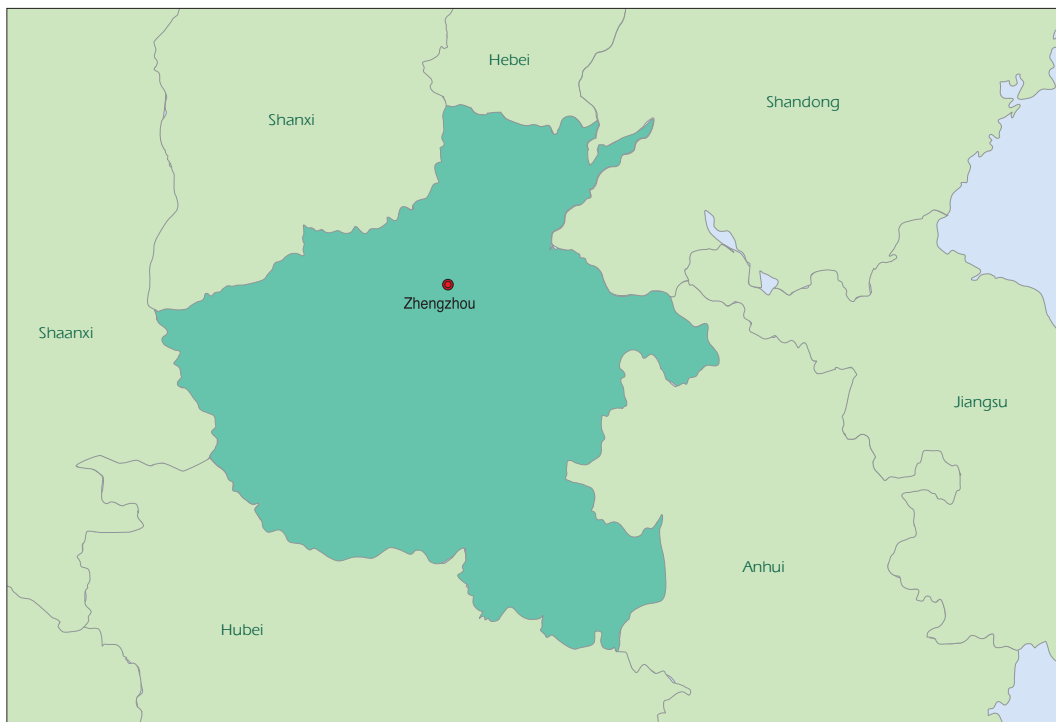
Longmen Grottoes



Henan's terrain slopes from west to east, with the mountain and hill area accounting for 44.3% of the province's total area, while the plain area accounting for 55.7%. There are four river systems running through the province: the Yellow River, the Huaihe River, the Weihe River and the Hanshui River, among which, the Huaihe River basin accounts for 53%.

Henan is one of the cradles of the Chinese civilization. The remains of some of the earliest human settlements have been unearthed here, including the over 7000-year-old Peiligang Culture Site, the 6000-year-old Yangshao Culture Remains and the 5000-year-old Dahe Culture Remains. All these cultural remains have profound significance in the history of the Chinese civilization. In Chinese history, there were over 20 dynasties set their capitals in or moved their capitals to Henan. Three of the seven ancient capitals that have been ascertained are in Henan. They are Anyang, capital of the Shang Dynasty, Luoyang, capital of nine dynasties and Kaifeng, capital of seven dynasties. And three of the four great inventions of ancient China, compass, papermaking and gunpowder were all invented in Henan.

The Longmen Grottoes in Luoyang, a famous treasure house of stone sculptures, has been inscribed to the World Heritage List.

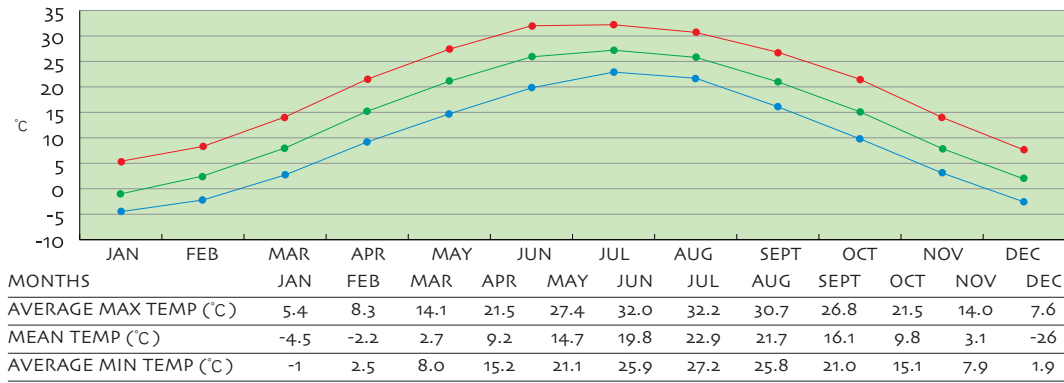

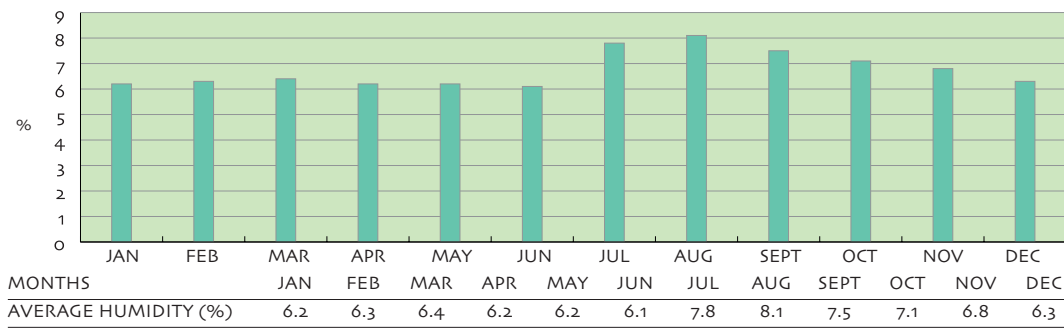
Zhengzhou is the capital city of Henan Province. It has the largest train marshalling yard in Asia and the biggest transit station for small loads of goods in China. The Xinzheng International Airport has routes leading to more than 30 cities both at home and abroad.

There are more than 1400 cultural relics in the city. The Shaolin Temple, known as the "No. 1 Famous Temple under Heaven" is located in the embrace of Mount Songshan, where the world famous Shaolin Kung Fu originates.

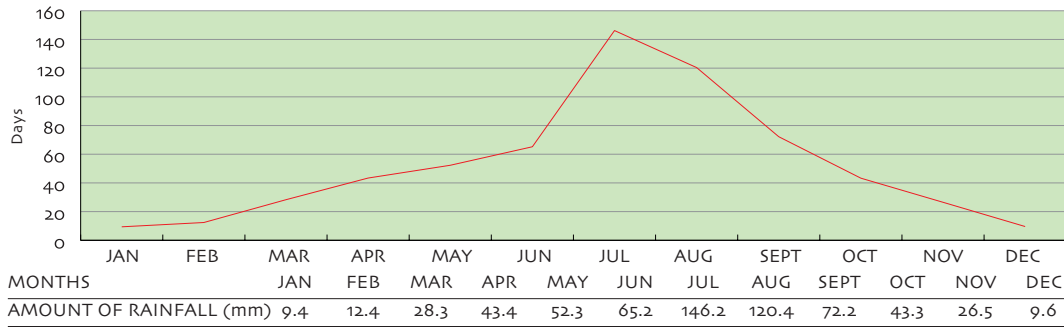
● AVERAGE MAX TEMP ● MEAN MONTHLY TEMP ● AVERAGE MIN TEMP

● PREVAILING WIND DIRECTION AND AVERAGE STRENGTH

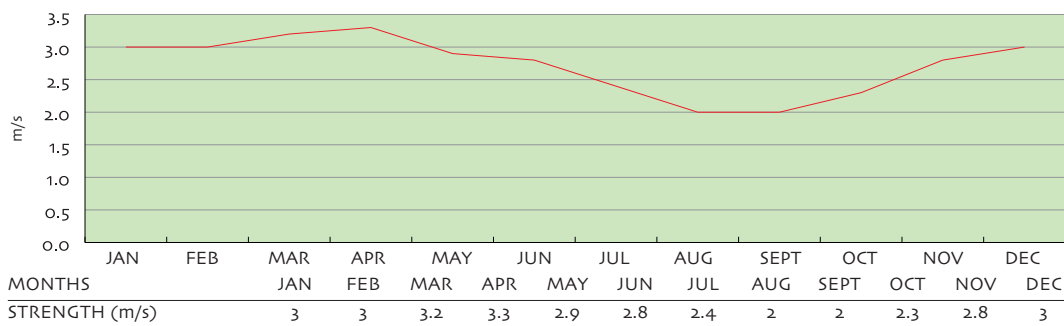
